



# Patricia Ricard President, Institut océanographique Paul Ricard

Patricia Ricard's commitment to defending the environment dates back to 1991 when she launched the *Les Mardis de l'Environnement* cycle of conferences and became a member of the Executive Board of the *Institut océanographique Paul Ricard*.

As an autodidact, it is through her actions that Patricia Ricard acquired her scientific and technical expertise in issues linking economics and ecology. She has presented broadcasts dedicated to the environment on a range of media (*MCM*, *Planète*, *RFI*, *Radio de la Mer*), and was a member of the *Conseil Économique Social et Environnemental* (CESE) (Economic, Social and Environmental Council) from 2010 to 2015, where she presented the report: *Le biomimétisme : s'inspirer de la nature pour innover durablement* ('Biomimetics: taking inspiration from nature to innovate sustainably').

Since 2005, she has been President of the *Institut océanographique Paul Ricard*, located on the island of Les Embiez (SE France). The mission of the Institute, which celebrated its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2016, is to provide nature-based solutions to reduce or eliminate pollution and damage resulting from human activity in the marine environment and the coastal zone.

Patricia Ricard is today committed to highlighting the essential role played by the Ocean and biodiversity in our response to mitigate and adapt to climate change and to raise awareness and mobilise public opinion and the decision-makers regarding these issues.

She is Vice-President of the Ocean & Climate Platform, a coalition of a hundred or so organisations acting to protect the Ocean and the climate in the framework of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG 13 and 14), and which supports the inclusion of the Ocean in the agenda of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC). It is in this capacity that she works to build bridges between the scientific community and the political and economic deciders, and provides assistance to industrial groups for their transition planning.

In 2019, she co-directed the workstream *Renforcer la résilience des écosystèmes marins* ('Strengthening the resilience of marine ecosystems') of the **One Planet Lab**, an initiative of President Macron, the results of which were presented at the One Planet Summit in Nairobi and Biarritz as G7 summit side events. She was also nominated as Lead of the French delegation at the *Sommet des Deux Rives* (Two Shores Summit).
